## Class one - Curls, Curls and more Curls

DANA Its time to start class

DANA we will give everyone 2 minutes and then hold our first contest

DANA of the day ...

DANA Before we begin ...

DANA here are the rules ...

DANA #1 - lets keep all personal chit chat till the end - so our non English

speaking friends have an easier time translating

DANA #2 - I will explain a section and then open the floor for questions ...

DANA this allows a great flow of topic - without being confusing

DANA #3 ... Moonyeen is taking notes and transcribing them for me to post on

my website

DANA tomorrow morning .... (or as soon as she has them set)

DANA There are no other notes needed ...

DANA So good Morning everyone! Ready to start?

DANA One way to make sure you are not kicked out of classroom ... is to make

sure and answer yes, no or whatever when I ask a question

DANA SOOooo with that in mind ... (we are almost full - how nice!)

DANA Lets begin ....

DANA CURLS

DANA As I start the wigging class series (Each Monday at 11am) ...

DANA I want to evolve into hair styles.

DANA BUT first - as always

DANA we need to understand the techniques

DANA in making the actual hair style.

DANA Sooo lets begin with curls

DANA Curls ... are very important tool in wigging

DANA but often are overused

DANA over curled

DANA and just over ugly <6> hahahah

DANA Think of long strands

DANA of Victorian perfect curls

sticking straight out DANA DANA on an otherwise beautiful Victorian dress! DANA Sooooo DANA Lets learn how to DANA cut divide DANA DANA spread out DANA pick apart and TEASE curls DANA DANA into creating a more realistic hairstyle. DANA 1. BASIC CURL DANA There are 3 styles of curls that I create. DANA Spit curl (the tiny ones around your face) DANA Tendrils (the soft dreaming ones that escape a bun) DANA Sausage curls (think little house on the prairie/Victorian hard ringlets) DANA Questions on what any of 1-3 look like? DANA I know you are another language - so no worries (you can read the notes ok?) DANA Alrighty recap: DANA 3 types of curls Now to the next section ... DANA 3 different ways to MAKE curls DANA DANA A) Make the curl and clamp with flat iron/hair straightener to truly set DANA B) Make the curls by wrapping around knitting needle and after letting dry about 5 minutes DANA pull off and let the damp curl loosen by itself DANA C) Wrap your curl (around a LARGE knitting needle) solid DANA and cut apart (or pull apart) to make PUFFs of hair. DANA So to recap: DANA A) flat iron DANA B) damp curl DANA c) puff curls DANA (and yes I will go into detail about the technique for each). DANA Did everyone see the 3 techniques for curls (A-C)? DANA No photos - today is just a warm up class with descriptions and class notes

Alrighty ...

Lets go into curl making techniques ...

A) Take a small section of viscose and gently pull both ends (DO NOT DANA CUT) until you reached the desired width/length of hair DANA DANA (this isn't rocket science hahah - no measurements - just trial and error of practice) In fact --- in class - I usually start out having the girls make 25 curls -DANA and out of that - usually 10 are wonderful to use. BUT they DANA get a chance to practice). DANA Ok ... back to Technique A DANA Take small section of viscose mist both sides lightly with distilled water and a drop of downey (green is DANA best) and for our foreign friends - this is simply fabric softener DANA and run viscose thru your fingers. DANA THEN wrap hair around a knitting needle, (think wrapping floral tape around a flower stem) and repeat DANA (until the knitting needle is filled) DANA THEN take your hair straightener (or flat iron - same thing) and clamp on viscose DANA turn, clam on viscose DANA turn DANA until the hair actually becomes shiny then you know it is \*set\*. DANA The MORE hair (fiber) you put on the knitting needle --- the FATTER the curl DANA The LARGER the knitting needle - the LOOSE the curl DANA Questions about Technique A (using a flat iron)? Jennifer S not about iron, but we have blue Downey, never saw green will that matter? Karin\_Lambert Does the flat iron work better than air drying or putting in warm oven DANA Jennifer - not really - I just like the way that green works - seems silkier for some reason <G> Karin - for me definitely YES! DANA DANA Alrighty ... DANA Lets move on to making damp curl styles DANA If you look at Margo (Deb hahaha) ... the latest class I taught - or can see on my webpage homepage .... DANA The curls are curls ... but a bit softer DANA The way I did this ... DANA was wrap the curls around knitting needle (see directions above)

Marilyn\_filter When you say 10 is that 0 needles fill DANA BUT after 5 minutes (and no flat iron) I pulled them off dampish DANA THEN carefully glued them on her head (one at a time) and let the doll dry overnight (i.e. curls) DANA THEN styled. The weight of the curls softened the ridges/curls and make hair a bit more realistic ... DANA then straight up \*ironed/ringlets). DANA (Marilyn --- I ask the girls to make 25 curls - (however many they can fit on a needle) and then choose 10 that are \*perfect\* ... DANA Now .. DANA once the damp curls have been attached to the dolls head DANA the weight of the curls overnight soften the actual ringlet DANA I can then - next morning - gently pick apart some of the sections DANA to loosen up the curl DANA (more on styling the curls in section #3). Right now we are just going over techniques Alrighty ... the last style is the #3 - PUFF CURLS DANA DANA If you take a larger knitting needle - say 8 American DANA and wrap viscose around it ...TIGHTLY and set the hair with the flat iron DANA and LET COOL at least 20 minutes DANA DANA WHEN you pull off this big log type curl You can actually cut it apart ... in sections ... DANA DANA and use as Flapper \*C\* type curls DANA (or pull both ends DANA and this makes a little type of rat (teased hair) DANA that can be used under her hair style DANA on top of her head for buns etc DANA Alrighty ---- that is the 3 ways to create the curls DANA A) Flat iron DANA B) damp curls DANA C) puff curls Any questions on making these? DANA DANA Ok - before I begin on the 3 ways I use curls (style) DANA Deb --- I know you agreed to a special on viscose hair today - for us ... whoo hooo what is it? DANA DANA (for those that need to purchase)

DANA we have discussed

DANA 3 kinds of curls ... (spit curl, tendril and sausage curl)

DANA 3 techniques to making these curls (flat iron, damp and puff curls)

DANA 1. PUZZLE piece ....

DANA This is my favorite.

DANA for this month

DANA on the list

DANA we have lavish Victorian

DANA For anyone trying to duplicate this complicated LOOKING hairstyle

DANA by using one long continuous piece

DANA (make sure you drink lots of wine hahahha)

DANA NO

DANA seriously ...

DANA If you view a hairstyle as a

DANA BASE

DANA Middle (can't think of name)

DANA and frosting DANA you will dissect the hairstyle DANA into 3 different parts. DANA Say a wigging cross ... DANA that covers the entire head in hair DANA 2. Then you glue on a top bun DANA (which makes it a basic hairstyle) 3. THEN add some forehead bangs and tendrils (as an accent/frosting on DANA a cake) DANA Basically --- you see a hairstyle DANA pick it apart in your minds eye DANA to all the little puzzle pieces DANA you need to glue on DANA to make it a whole hairstyle DANA Questions on the puzzle piece theory? Styling #2 ... FAKE HEIGHT DANA DANA Think Marie Antoinette DANA or a stylish beehive 60 DANA 60's hairdo DANA or Gibson girl bulk at the sides DANA You can achieve all these with different sections of the \*PUFF\* Curl ... glued on head ... and then teased into combining with a wigging cross or other curls to make the hair LOOK like one hairstyle. DANA FOR example ... Marie Antoinette ... DANA DANA I like to do a wigging cross (to cover the whole head with hair) DANA Then I take one of my larger puff curls .... glue it to the very TOP front of head .... DANA DANA and back tease with a corsage pin to give it height. DANA THEN hairspray the teased curl lightly DANA and DAB it with your finger to shape it into a round or oval shape (HINT HINT .. I cover my finger with plastic wrap and then dab the DANA lightly misted hairstyle) DANA you can shape it all kinds of ways! DANA Once you get the height you wish .... DANA simply glue on 3 more lateral curls at the back DANA (horizontal) to cover the back of the head! DANA DANA Add a front curl, tendrils and a whole hairstyle has just been born!

center/curve to the head?

nathalie G what do you do with your wigging cross hair?

nathalie G you tight them upwards?

DANA Jennifer - yes!

nathalie G before gluing the curls over them?

DANA Nathalie G - I gather at top like Arianna Grande ponytail - wrap with

thread and cut off excess. This then gives a base to the PUFF (height

curl)

nathalie G ok makes sense ty

DANA You are welcome!

DANA First one -

DANA Continuous motion style!

Jane Oh my goodness yes, thank you

DANA yes!

DANA We had puzzle technique

DANA the Height technique

NathM I don't understand what does it mean

DANA and now ... we will discuss the continuous technique

DANA (or how to pick apart curls to make wavy hair ...

DANA instead of lots of curls hair)

DANA ok?

DANA Here we go ...

DANA This style has a bit of practice before you can achieve it.

DANA Basically what you are doing - is making a larger curl ...

DANA (say on size 5 American knitting needle)

DANA and after the curl is set

DANA you pick it apart with two corsage pins ...

DANA to make into many little wavy strands of hair

DANA Soooo visualize

DANA ONE CURL

DANA then holding it with two corsage pins

DANA using one to gently separate the fibers

DANA so there are lots of wavy hair strands

DANA instead of one big curl

DANA You then glue these sections on doll's head

DANA	and you get a wavy continuous flow of hair
DANA	Questions?
DANA	Alrighty my ladies that is class for today! A bit over the 30 minutes but I hope you enjoyed and learned something new.
DANA	Next Monday is our next wigging class - as we go into different ways to make buns and braids!
